YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED TO BOIL ALL WATER FOR DRINKING AND CULINARY PURPOSES. THIS ORDER IS BEING ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 1107 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW. THIS ORDER IS BEING ISSUED TO EVER KNOWN USER OF BOLTON ACRES.

DO NOT DRINK THE WATER WITHOUT BOILING IT FIRST. Bring all water to a boil in a clean container, let it boil for one minute, and let it cool before using, use bottle water certified by NYSDOH, or use water from a public water system approved by NYSDOH. Boiled or bottled water certified by NYSDOH should be used for drinking, making ice, washing dishes, brushing teeth and food preparation until further notice.

The Boil Water Order is being issued as a precaution based on the loss of pressure in the system due to a faulty pressure switch. Consumers will be notified as soon as the Boil Water Order is rescinded.

The Boil Water Order shall only be lifted when water line pressures are restored and two consecutive daily samples show no bacteriological contamination.
