**THIS ORDER IS BEING ISSUED TO ALL KNOWN USERS OF THE WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM
AT BOLTON'S ACRES.**

YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED TO BOIL ALL WATER FOR DRINKING AND CULINARY PURPOSES. THIS ORDER IS BEING ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 1107 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW.

DO NOT DRINK THE WATER WITHOUT BOILING IT FIRST. Bring all water to a boil in a clean container, let it boil for one minute, and let it cool before using, use bottled water certified by NYSDOH, or use water from a public water system approved by NYSDOH. Boiled or bottled water certified by NYSDOH should be used for drinking, making ice, washing dishes, brushing teeth, and food preparation until further notice.

The Boil Water Order is being issued as a precaution because Total Coliform bacteria was detected in a routine water sample and no disinfection system is in use. Therefore, consumption of the water, without boiling, may pose a public health hazard.

Consumers will be notified as soon as the Boil Water Order is rescinded. The Boil Water Order will remain in effect until satisfactory Coliform bacteria samples are collected.
